## History of Jordan and Palestine (110196) 3credit hours)

The course introduces students to the history of Jordan and Palestine during the old ages, then the Islamic era, and finally the Ottoman period. Afterwards, it proceeds to analyze in detail how East Jordan Emirate was founded and how Palestine was put under British mandate. It finally discusses how Jordan got independence and the role it plays in the Palestinian issue.

In general, the course aims to achieve the following:

- 1- To acquaint students with the common history of both Jordan and Palestine throughout old ages.
- 2- To acquaint students with the history of both Jordan and Palestine during the Islamic epoch .
- 3- To make students cognizant of the significance of Jordan and Palestine from the strategic and geographical perspectives .
- 4- To make students aware of the common fate the two countries have .
- 5- To make students know Jordan's defending stance regarding the Palestinian issue in the international arena.
