102431 Classical Literature (3 CHs)

This course aims to familiarize students with the masterpieces of classical literature, such as the Iliad of Homer, the Aeniad of Virgil and the plays of Sophocles, Euripides, Aeschylus, and some of Plato's writings. The course should focus on the technical aspects of the selected masterpieces: aspects of form and style as well as analytical accounts of content and philosophical implications there in.
