I. Success on the Licensure Exam

Table # 1: Graduates Successful Completion Rate in “Jordan Nursing Licensure Exam” in 2024 as Reported by the Jordanian Nursing Council (JNC)

As shown in table # 1, and as reported by the JNC, the successful completion rate of the graduates of the Faculty of Nursing at Isra University in 2024 is 67.4% that is below the national mean score (73.3%). The successful completion rate of the regular program graduates (70.4%) is higher than that of the bridging program graduates (66.1%).

This result prompted the academic departments' faculty members to set improvement plans in all reported domains (i.e., Adult Health Nursing, Mental Health Nursing, Maternity Nursing, Child Health nursing, Community Health Nursing, and Leadership and Management in Nursing). Therefore, we look forward to seeing improvement in the successful completion rate of our graduates in the “Jordan Nursing Licensure Exam” in 2025.

II. Program Completion Rate, AY 2023/ 2024

Note: The expected level of achievement (ELA) is as follows:

- 75% of the students will complete on time that is 8 semesters for regular and 4 semesters for bridging program students (this duration of time completion is equivalent to 100%).
- 25% may use the maximum completion time that is 14 semesters for regular and 6 semesters for bridging program students (this duration of time completion is equivalent to 150%).
